This is in no way an attempt to reduce the challenge for pupils taking part, but an attempt to make the play more accessible to a wider audience and to help nurture a love of classical theatre in them. The production will feature a new 'cinematic' score, incorporating elements especially recorded for this production by internationally acclaimed aulos player Barnaby Brown.

Sophocles' play, first performed in 429BC, follows Oedipus' discovery of a dark family secret that threatens not only to destroy the city but the King himself.
