Reporting Problems to West Berkshire Council

West Berkshire Council is responsible for many of the facilities in the village (roads, footpaths, litter bins etc.). It is quick and easy to report a problem on their website - westberks.gov.uk and then choose Report a Problem. You do get a response, and they will tell you if you they are not the right people to be contacting.

Planning

The following planning applications were considered at the meeting:

19/01274/REM Equibreed Ltd., Grange Lane. Worker's accommodation. Revised details were submitted lowering the height of the building. Approval has already been given by WBC.

19/01810/HOUSE 18 Mount Pleasant. Side and rear extension. No objection.

19/02035/HOUSE Wayround. Single storey extension and new garage. No objection.

19/02048/FULEXT Land adjacent to Flexistay Hotel, Bath Road, Padworth. 15 two-bedroom apartments.

This is just outside Beenham Parish, but the PC has been consulted. The PC objected on the grounds of over-development and also access to the site (which will be through the hotel car-park).

19/02071/HOUSE 4 Randolph Gardens, Bath Road, Padworth. Rear extension and loft conversion. No objections.

19/01758/FULD Beenham Grange. First floor extension to provide an additional 4 apartments.

The owners have written to PC confirming their agreement to providing a footpath on part of the access road to Beenham Grange and also to increase in the amenity area (subject to agreement with WBC).

The PC agreed to discuss the pathway with Marley Eternit, to see if the pathway could be extended further down the access road on Marley land.
