WI Bench

The location of the bench has been agreed with WBC. It will be installed shortly.

Christmas Tree

We asked for your views on a permanent Christmas Tree. Some people were in favour, and some against. WBC did not approve our proposal for a permanent tree. PC decided that they would not proceed with a permanent tree at the moment.

Community Transport

The PC wrote to WBC about the withdrawing of funding for ReadiBus. We received the following reply.

The Council is grateful to ReadiBus for the service provided, and whilst this is very regrettable for passengers who use ReadiBus services in Newbury and Thatcham, we are keen to ensure that effected customers are aware that there are other community transport groups providing services for local residents who are unable to use public transport and need to attend medical appointments or make shopping trips.

Community transport groups operating in the Beenham and the surrounding area, include:

- Carebus Volunteer Group operate a car and handybus (minibus) scheme:
 - Contact them on 0118 930 4837. They operate a 24/7 messaging service, calls requiring answering will be returned on same day or the next day.
- Chapel Row Community Group offer transport for those unable to use public transport to go to medical appointments and to make shopping trips.
 - Contact 0118 971 3334 on Mon, Wed and Fri between hours of 0930 1130.

Eligible residents using the Community Car Scheme or Handybus (minibus) will be asked to make

a contribution towards the cost of the service. The fee would be discussed when making a booking. Where it is possible, customers are asked to give at least three days' notice prior to any journey required.

Finance

- The Year End Accounts for 2020-21 were presented, together with the Internal Auditor's Report. The accounts were agreed by the PC, together with the Annual Government & Accountability Return. These documents will be available on the PC website.
- The PC considered a request from the Victory Hall Management Committee for a contribution to the cost of resurfacing part of the area outside the Hall. The PC agreed that £1,000 would be available if it was match-funded through Good Exchange, and if the funding for the full cost was confirmed.

Next Meeting

The law says that PC meetings must be held in a public place, with room for the public to attend. Emergency legislation approved online meetings during the pandemic, but this has now expired. It is likely that the June meeting will be held online, and this will be an "informal" meeting (with no strict legal standing). The PC has delegated powers to the Clerk so that essential payments can continue.

We hope that the July PC meeting will be face-to-face again.

The next Parish Council meeting will be online on Monday 7th June, starting at 7.00pm. All parishioners are welcome to attend, but please contact the Parish Clerk beforehand if you wish to speak.
